## Garnett Place is Adding a New Program

Garnett Place is in the final stages of realizing the addition of a Memory Care Unit.

The Memory Care Unit will be located on the 3rd Floor of the 208 Building. Five apartments will comprise the Unit. **Anyone currently living on the 3rd Floor will not have to move.**

The current 3rd Floor Dining Room will be relocated to the Lower Level of the 208 Building.

The Dining Room on third will be converted to a combination Activity / Dining Room for Memory Care.

The only change for current residents on the 3rd Floor will be the new Dining Room location on the Lower Level.

The schedule for upcoming changes in May will include:

- Work will begin on the new Dining Room on the Lower Level.
- The exercise equipment will be moved into J.P. current office. J.P. will relocate to the 2nd Floor.
- The vending machines will be moved to another area.
- The pool table will **NOT** be moved.

So...we are asking your help in assisting us in knowing where you are. New door clips are coming and all we ask is that you leave a note on your

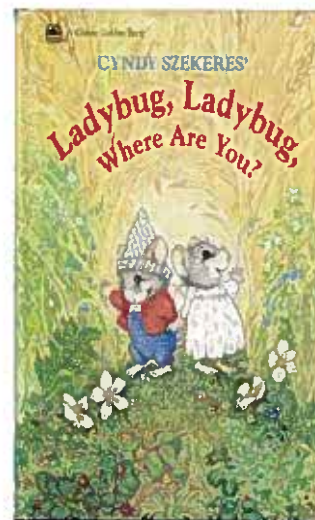

As a bonus, J.P. will periodically include some of the recipes in his monthly menu.

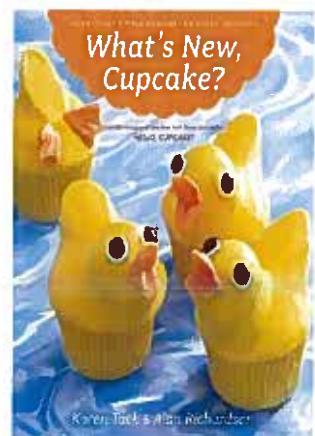


