According to the National Centers for Disease Control and Prevention seasonal flu vaccines protect against three influenza viruses. Research indicates which flu viruses will be most common during the upcoming season.

The viruses in the vaccine can change each year. The CDC has information about which types and strains of viruses will circulate in a given year.

About 2 weeks after the vaccination, antibodies that provide

protection against the influenza viruses in the vaccine, develop in the body.
